

## Jonathan Shively

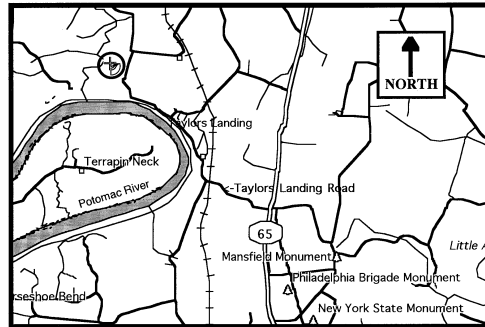
