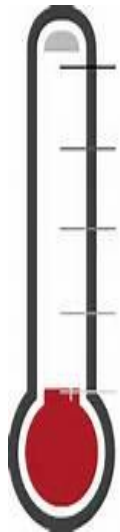


THE DREAM

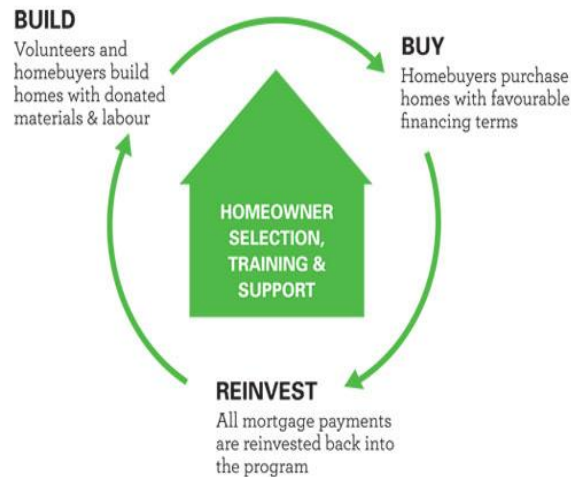
