The new addition to the Bowman Center, the Adult day Care Center, and the Community Building are in the finishing stages of construction, with an anticipated June completion date and a July dedication.

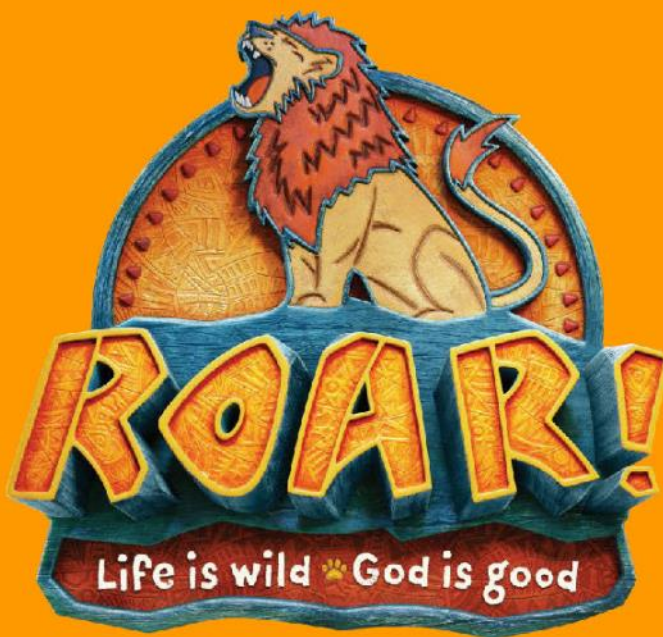

NOAC BUS 2019

The Mid-Atlantic District will be chartering a motor coach to the National Older Adult Conference (NOAC) in Lake Junaluska, NC, September 2-6, 2019. Cost for the coach will not exceed \$165 per person round trip (based on 30 passengers minimum). Details about NOAC registration, lodging and meals can be found at <http://www.brethren.org/noac>.

The coach will depart from the Union Bridge COB on September 2 at 6:00 am, pick up at Frederick COB at 6:30 am, Manassas COB at 7:45 am, and Bridgewater COB at 9:45 am, arriving at Lake Junaluska, NC in time for afternoon registration. Return trip departs Friday, September 6 at the conclusion of the morning session, arriving home Friday night.

For those traveling a distance to the Union Bridge departure point, overnight lodging for September 1 and 6 will be available in the Carroll County, MD area by contacting: Pat Ecker (410-871-0765 or email plecker@qis.net).

Reservations for the coach will be accepted thru July 1 on a first-come-first-served basis, with a deposit of \$50 per person. **Checks should be made payable to Mid-Atlantic District.** You will be notified in July of the balance due on August 1 (this is dependent upon the number of passengers).
