Jeff Bach, Friday Worship Preacher and Saturday Bible Study

Jeff Bach is director of the Young Center for Anabaptist and Pietist Studies at Elizabethtown College and teaches courses on the history of Anabaptist and Pietist groups and communal societies in the Department of Religious Studies. Before coming to the Young Center in 2007 he taught for thirteen years at Bethany Theological Seminary in Richmond, Indiana. He earned a Ph.D. in religion from Duke University in 1997, concentrating on the history of Christianity and is an ordained minister in the Church of the Brethren. He has studied and written on topics related to Radical Pietist groups in Europe and America, including the Ephrata Cloister in Pennsylvania. He is the author of Voices of the Turtledoves: The Sacred World of Ephrata (Penn State Press, 2003) and collaborator with Michael Birkel for Genius of the Transcendent: Mystical Writings of Jakob Boehme (Shambhala, 2010). He wrote a chapter on Jacob Boehme that appears in the new book, Protestants and Mysticism in Reformation Europe, published by Brill Press in March 2019.




