You may be wondering why you're getting an email about 2025 Camp Mardela staff already! Well - some of you have been on staff before, some of you have volunteered before, and some of you have shown a lot of promise to potentially be a volunteer or staff member for the first time. Already, 2025 is shaping up to be a very exciting - but very busy year, and I want to make sure that we have the leadership to be able to manage these camps. So I wanted to make you aware of the potential program schedule, and our staff and volunteer needs. If you do not know your plans for summer yet, that is fine. But if you DO know your plans, let me know if you think you will be able to help or not, and I can adjust the information I send out accordingly as we get closer to needing these volunteers and staff.

- Family Camp Aug 29-31 Directors: Family Camp Committee
 - Staff 2 kitchen staff, 1 maintenance, 1 resource

The compensation scale for volunteers has been slightly adjusted to as follows:

- Weekend/Half-Week counselor or resource 10% off camp voucher
- Full Week counselor or resource 20% off camp voucher
- Camp Director (any length) 40% off camp voucher

Summer staff salaries will still be a minimum of \$400 per week, and part-time staff minimum will be \$12/week.

If you think you may be able to help out in any capacity with these programs, please let me know. Also let me know if you know for sure that you can't, so I can recruit staff and volunteers accordingly.
